

## **Frequently Asked Questions about the NJBA Honey Show**

1. **Who can enter the Honey Show?** Any member of the NJBA whose dues are paid at time of judging. Only one entry per family membership in each class.
2. **Does it cost anything to enter?** No, just the cost of glassware and labels or packaging.
3. **What is the prize for winning?** Ribbons for first, second, third. Best in Show and Division Best receive rosettes, and have their name inscribed on the Honey Show brass plaque displayed at the Honey Show and the Annual Winter Meeting..
4. **How does my entry get delivered to the judges?** Check with your Branch Executive Board members, or go online to [NJBeekeepers.org](http://NJBeekeepers.org). The entries are due at the Rutgers Eco Complex in Bordentown by noon Wednesday, February 7th. 5. **Will I get my entry back?** First Place, Division Best and Best in Show winners are auctioned at the Annual Winter Meeting. The rest are returned to entrants . All entries get a judging sheet. If you are not attending the Winter Meeting, make sure you have designated someone who is to pick up your entries.
6. **Are labels ok?** Yes, put on labels on all products. The judging will be done by someone from out of state.

8. **When and where is the show?** The judging this year takes place on Thursday and Friday, February 8th, and 9th at the Rutgers' Eco Complex in Bordentown.

The winners will be displayed at the State Annex Tunnel in Trenton for the following week of February 12 to 16

On February 17 th and 18th, is the Winter Meeting. There is an auction on Saturday evening of winners.
