Introductory courses in beekeeping are offered by Rutgers and branches of the New Jersey Beekeepers Association (NJBA). In 2012, the [Rutgers course](#) will be held in Bordentown, NJ, on April 26-28, 2012. The [Essex](#) branch course will be held February 18 and 25, 2012 in Roseland, NJ. The [Sussex](#) branch course in Augusta, NJ, are not available yet, and the [Jersey Cape](#) branch will offer their class on Friday evenings from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. in Cape May Court House from February 17, 2012 through March 23, 2012, with the last session on a Saturday in April when the bees arrive.

Candidates must provide their own transportation, but tuition and meal fees, if any, will be paid for by the NJBA, for recipients. Students must be full-time students between the ages of 12 and 22 when the course they are applying for begins.
