2018 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Introductory courses in beekeeping are offered by the New Jersey Beekeepers Association (NJBA) and branches of the NJBA. In 2017, the [Essex](#) branch course was held on two successive Saturdays, February 18 and 25, 2017 in Roseland, NJ: a field date was held in April. The [Sussex](#) branch course in Augusta, NJ, was held on two successive Saturdays on January 21 and 28 with a February 4 snow date and the [Jersey Cape](#) branch usually offers their class on Friday evenings from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. in Cape May Court House typically starting in February, with the last session on a Saturday in April when the bees arrive. The South Jersey branch offered a course on six consecutive Saturday starting on February 4, 2017 at the Extension office in Millville. *You can check the [Education page](#) of our website which will be updated with 2018 information when it becomes available.*

Candidates must provide their own transportation, but tuition and meal fees, if any, will be paid for by the NJBA for recipients. Students must be full-time students between the ages of 12 and 22 when the course they are applying for begins.
